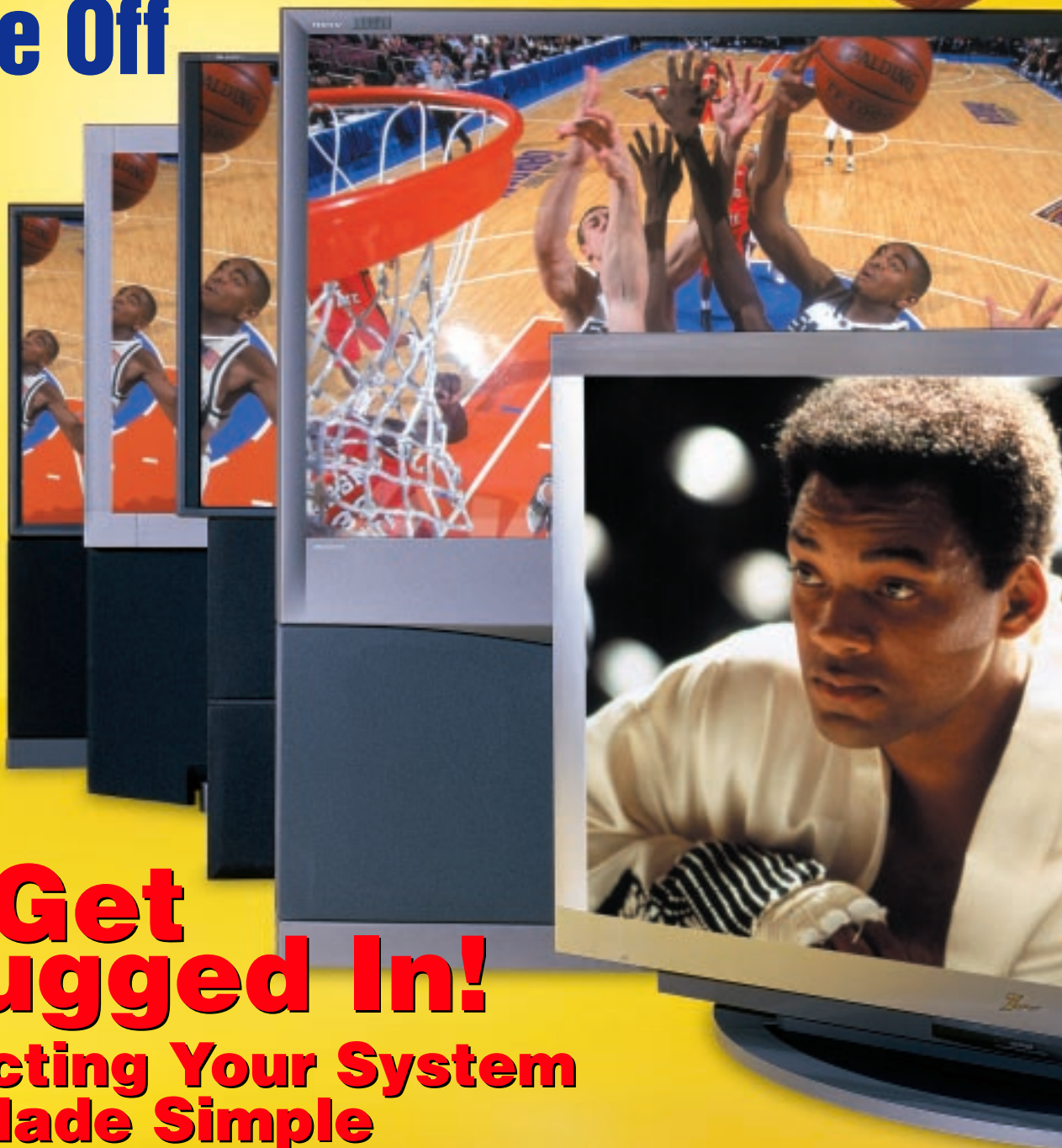

Sound that hits the spot.

Shiny orbs of silver that produce surround sound? We can almost hear your skepticism. Morel's SoundSpot SA-2 two-way, two-unit, magnetically shielded speaker is just that.

This true two-way system features a 4-inch midbass driver and a soft-dome tweeter, each of which is housed in its own acoustic chamber—a perfectly shaped steel dome—that Morel says minimizes sonic coloration and eliminates music-distorting resonance.

The SA-2's tweeter is a soft dome that's hand-coated with Acuflex, a material that's said to prevent resonance and reduce distortion. The dome is supported by a 1.125-inch liquid-cooled voice coil. Because of the voice coil's large diameter, the tweeter's frequency range is extended down to the midrange band.

These characteristics allow for the use of a simple, first-order crossover (there are only two components), which minimizes crossover-induced disturbances and preserves the clarity and transparency of the sound.

These mighty mites perform optimally at around 120 watts of power and are pictured here with their big brother, the Morel SoundSub IS-9 subwoofer. The IS-9 was designed to supplement the SoundSpot satellite speakers in

of the enclosure.

Both the passive and the active sub have two 9-inch flat-profiled woofers with a 3-inch Hexatech aluminum coil and a rear-vented double-magnet motor.

The space-age-looking SA-2 comes with an integral base for easy and flexible installation. You can place the speaker on a shelf or hang it from a wall or ceiling. The



speaker is magnetically shielded, so you can place it on top of your TV. The pivoting base allows you to adjust the speaker angle for optimal acoustic orientation.

A stylish stand is also available to complement the speakers, and it's no lightweight: It's fabricated of solid

metal, which provides high mass and extreme rigidity. The stand is blessedly configured to conceal internal wiring and is sure to keep these stunning orbs looking cool in any home theater.
